The WCA nursery (ages 6 weeks-2 years) is open any day that students are in attendance for school. Registration for the nursery is \$125.00. The nursery rate is \$130 per week. On days that WCA is closed, the rate will be prorated at \$26 per day. This ONLY applies when WCA is closed. You will be responsible for the weekly amount if your child is absent.

Needed for enrollment:

- **\$125.00** Registration Fee per student
- Completed enrollment form (attached)
- Student Physical Form (to be completed by doctor)
- Medicine Permission Form (pink)
- DSS Form #2900 (green)
- Immunization Record
- Birth Certificate

Discounts: In an effort to promote a classroom atmosphere and maintain DSS guidelines our nursery rates are not eligible for discounts. The Multiple Child and Paid in Full discounts are offered to students in 3K-8th grade only. For any questions, please contact the office.

Tuition Payments: You may use a Mastercard, AE or Discover for ONLINE payments through Family Portal, however there is a small fee to do so. You may also pay by check through Family Portal or sign up for bank draft (forms available from office). A **LATE FEE** will be assessed if accounts are two or more weeks past due

Registration: This fee is due upon enrollment. It reserves your child's spot and covers expenses such as processing, furniture, equipment, campus maintenance and the like. This fee is non-refundable.

Referral Credit: A \$25.00 credit is available to currently enrolled, tuition paying families who refer new families to WCA. A credit will be applied to the current family's account upon a written referral from the new student's family (on enrollment form).
